Digital Dash Repair

I know that some of you have heard the story of Daryl's dash repair back when he had his '84. Daryl removed his dash, sent it in for repair at a cost of approximately \$300, and found that the dash didn't work right when he got it back. Out it came again, and back it went to the shop. He got it back again, reinstalled it, and again it didn't work. Out it came for a third time, and before it was all said and done, Daryl had his Vette out of service for about two months and was somewhat frustrated by the apparent inability of the repair shop to get the job done right.

I have a different story to tell! The digital dash in my '91 Jimmy became intermittent last fall, and finally quit altogether the beginning of this year. I too was frustrated because the dash wouldn't come out of the car using the GM shop manual procedure, but I finally got it removed in April.

I had talked to Delphi by e-mail several times trying to get a schematic of the dash so I could hopefully repair it, but to no avail. Delphi did, however, give me a list of companies that repaired their dashes. Since I was too cheap to go to a dealer since they all want about \$300 (that's a familiar sounding number, isn't it?), I started calling close companies about the repair.

One place in Dallas would repair the dash, but only if sent in by a dealer. One in Georgia would repair the dash for about \$148, but they would have it for two to three weeks! I finally stumbled onto Instrument Sales and Service, a company that has repair shops in Portland, Seattle, and Denver. I called Instrument Sales and Service at 800-888-7976 and they quoted \$230 to remanufacture the dash. Although I didn't really need the dash remanufactured, I sent it in with an authorization to repair the dash up to a maximum of \$230 and to return it by next day air. You can imagine my shock when I received my repaired dash and a bill for \$58.24, which included \$15.00 for return shipping! By the way, the dash worked fine when reinstalled, unlike Daryl's repaired dash. Did I mention Instrument Sales and Service can be reached 800-888-7976? I asked if they also repaired Corvette dashes, expecting a higher price, but was told that they too would be remanufactured for a cost of \$230. My faith in humanity has been restored! There really is a company out there that will repair a digital dash for a reasonable cost, and best of all, do it right the first time! Thanks, Instrument Sales and Service! If you have problems

with your C-4 digital dash and the repair procedure in the June 2000 Corvette Fever magazine doesn't work or scares you, why not give Instrument Sales and Service a call at 800-888-7976. I think you'll be pleasantly surprised by their service.
