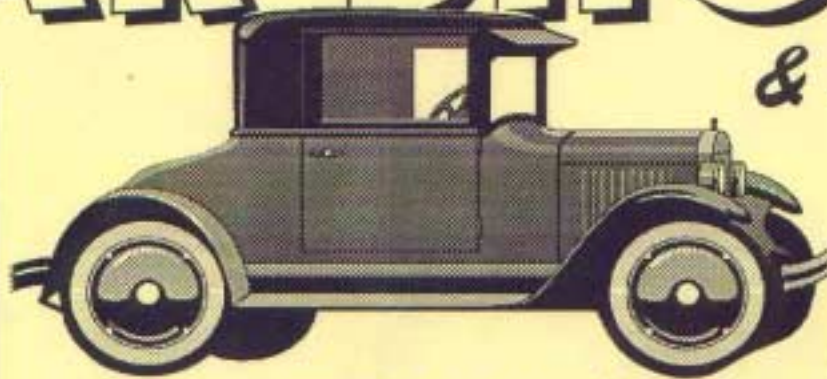
### 30th Annual WACCC All Wheels Car Show June 9, 2002 - 11:00am to 4:00pm

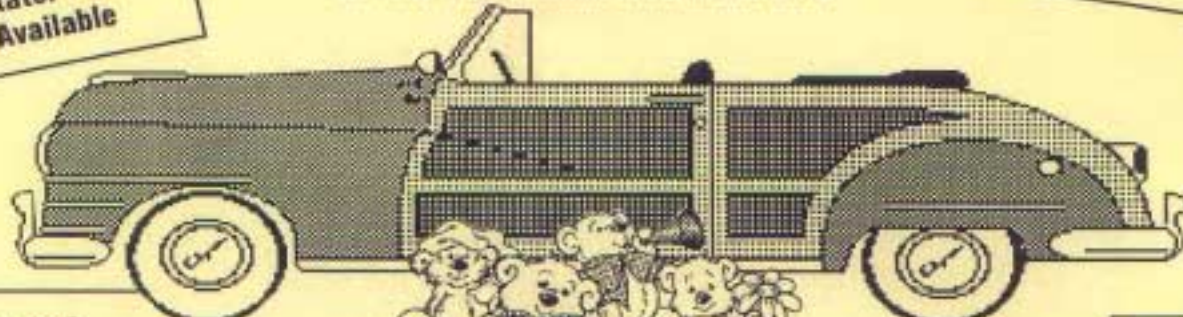
