Missouri/Kansas CARAVAN ROUTE for '03

A caravan from Denver Co will head east for Independence, Missouri on I-70 for an overnight stop Tuesday and our caravan begins from there...

Wednesday morning, we will hook up with the Kansas City caravan and head for St.Louis via I-70.

With a little luck, we will hook up with the St.Louis caravan at lunchtime on the east side of St.Louis. We will then take I-64 to I-164 in Indiana. This will take us to catch the Audubon parkway in Kentucky and then the Natcher Parkway for a beautiful drive into Bowling Green. The Natcher Parkway drops you off on I-65 just south of the hotels on Scottsville Rd. in Bowling Green or it's less than an hour south on I-65 to Nashville should you not be able to make hotel accomodations in Bowling Green proper.

We will be arriving in Bowling Green late Wednesday afternoon. This will give everyone a chance to get situated in their hotels Wednesday evening. This leaves time for plant tours and naps on Thursday morning and afternoon so that everyone will be ready to party hard Thursday evening!

There are three sections of toll road along the way. I-70 between Topeka and KC is toll. It's about \$4.00 I think. The Audubon Parkway is toll and is \$.50 as I recall and the Natcher Parkway has several \$.50 and \$.75 stops on it. The drive on the Natcher is absolutely beautiful.

I have reserved 50 rooms for the incoming caravan at the Hilton Garden Inn, 19677 E. Jackson Drive, Independence, MO 64057 816-350-3000 at a special rate of \$79.00 (about 25% off). More rooms can be blocked as necessary.

The Hilton Garden Inn is located at Exit 17 East Bound Interstate 70 and is located in the same parking lot they we will launch from the following morning.
