Drive and Eat - Keith and Margaret Wilkinson will host on Sat. April 4. They are heading north from the truck stop at 5:30pm.


Swap & Shop - Jim Phares has a 2004 Torch Red hood for sale for \$200.00. Monte has a new supply of his car detailer/cleaner.



Associate membership, designed for the non-Corvette owner, is \$25.00 per year for new members and \$20.00 per year for renewals. Associate membership does not include spouse or N.C.C.C. membership.

A.C.C.C. requires all members to be at least 18 years of age and hold a current valid driver's license.

Dues for renewals are payable on September 1st and are considered delinquent after the November A.C.C.C. meeting. Renewals received after the November meeting will be considered as new. Memberships received after September 1st will be valid through the next calendar year.
